Administrative Review Tribunal

The Administrative Review Tribunal (ART) will commence operations on 14 October 2024. The new federal review body will replace the Administrative Appeals Tribunal (AAT).

Legislation to abolish the AAT and replace it with the ART passed the Parliament in May 2024.
